### Pin Traders Club of Virginia (PTCV)

### Regular Issue

The pins shown in this Book have been issued by the first Multiple District pin trading club in Lionism. The concept of a separate Multiple District pin trading club was the idea of PCC Bill Smith, Fairfax Host Lions Club, 24-A. memorandum in December of 1981 to a group of interested pin traders in District 24-A who were members of the Lions International Trading Pin Club (LITPC). These Lions met at the Holiday Inn in Manassas on January 18, 1982 and worked out a constitution that was agreeable to all present. The PTCV was "born" that evening and since then, over 40 similar clubs have formed throughout Lionism. The Founders of the PTCV, in alphabetical order, were Curtis A. Barnhill, Robert M. Curry, Charles W. Fields, Harry Fulwiler, III, Montie Gibson, David E. Harris, Neil Hicks, James Kidwell, Joseph S. Lipomi, William A. McClain, Daniel McLachlan, Dave Mangione, Donald Moore, Irvin L. Poole, William A. Smith, J.O. Ward, and Raymond Welch. The pin shown below is the Founders Pin and was not intended to be a trading pin in the true sense. The distribution was limited to the Founding Members living at the time of issue. It is inevitable that one or more of the pins will show up on the trading market, and we want everyone to know what the original intent of the pin was at the time it was


