At the latest meeting of the Virginia Pin Trades Board of Directors, President Chet Kramer, after discussion by the Board, appointed a committee to initiate this program concerning Virginia pins. In that respect, we are asking all members of the Pin Traders Club of Virginia to participate by identifying those pins that they believe are the most difficult find. We are asking each of you to list in the order you deem most difficult the following:

- o Virginia Multiple District and Special Issue Pins. Please list your Top 10.
- **o** Virginia District Pins. Please list your Top 5.
- o Virginia Club Pins. Please list your Top 10.
- o Virginia Pin Trader Club (PTCV) Pins. Please list your Top 5.
- O Virginia Personal Pins. Please list your Top 5.

You can list a set of pins as one entry, or an individual pin from a set as one entry. For example if it is your opinion, say, that the Presidential set should be listed then it could be one of the ten entries for the MD pins. If on the other hand you feel that the George Washington Pin in that set is the most difficult and the others are not, then you could list that pin as a single entry.
